Colina Secreta Glamping and Villas is a family-run glamping hotel settled over 6 acres jungle private reserve at 1.6 km from the Caribbean Sea of Costa Rica, 5 km from Puerto Viejo Town. Colina Secreta is a place where you can connect with yourself, get inspired by the sounds of the tropical jungle and experience the enchanting atmosphere and warm hospitality.



AMENITIES AND SERVICES

The Colina Secreta main Villa is a charming colonial-style house. On the first floor, there is a Gallery Art, we have brought furniture and décor from Europe, Africa, Asia, and regional that can be purchased. Prices are available upon request.

The Hotel has 9 luxury glamping tent, 1 room in the first floor of the main villa, 1 small villa for 2, and 1 large villa for up to 4 people.

There is a small plunge pool by the main villa.

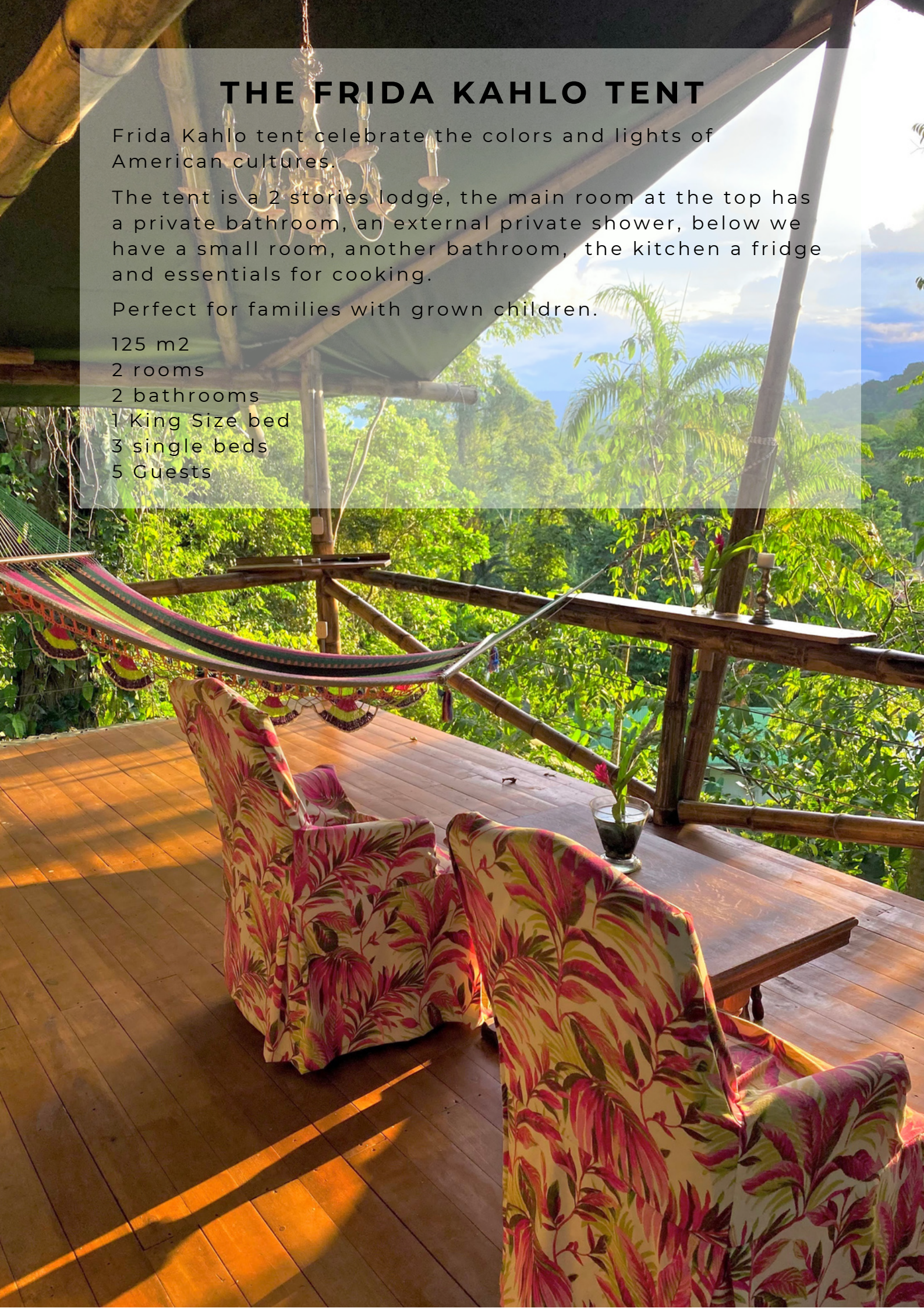
